

● BALTIMORE & OHIO has received ICC permission to install traffic control between and in the vicinity of Eidenau and West Penn Crossing, Pa., about 20 miles.

B&O is installing a traffic control system between Willard, Ohio and Pine Jct., Ill., \$3,928,360, about 75% complete. System train radio on the Monongahela division in West Virginia, costing \$1,800,000 is 90% complete. Projects for next year, also reported to *Railway Age*, include the following: Expansion of train radio—\$1,400,000; hotbox detectors—\$500,000; radio controlled signaling—\$500,000; automatic highway grade crossing protection at Akron, Ohio—\$200,000; and Wheel Checkers—\$100,000.
